

What We Heard from You: **Far Southeast & Southwest**

Public Comment

- Address stakeholder concerns about displacement due to new development.
- Encourage and incentivize more shopping options (particularly grocery stores).
- Provide more recreational facilities and activities for youth.
- Co-locate senior housing with health facilities and social services.
- Balance new development with a plan for improving educational facilities.

Agency Input

- Restore cultural and public facilities throughout Historic Anacostia.
- Incorporate recommendations from DDOT's *Far Southeast II Livability Study*, an evaluation of the SE neighborhoods south of Massachusetts Ave, north of Good Hope and Naylor Roads, west of South Capitol Street.
- Sustain and support existing health care facilities in Far Southeast-Southwest. Develop additional health care and social service facilities to respond to the urgent unmet need for primary care, pre- and post-natal care, child care, youth development, family counseling, nutrition education, and drug and alcohol treatment centers.
- Attract additional supermarkets, a variety of food retail, sit-down family-style restaurants, full-service gas stations, and general merchandise stores to the Far Southeast/Southwest.
