Public Comment

- Maintain and improve quality of life in older residential areas.
- Preserve historic assets and design quality of older neighborhoods.
- Avoid displacement of long-time residents and create more affordable housing.
- Better leverage existing open spaces to create more parks and recreational opportunities to keep up with growing population.
- Improve east-west transit connections.

Agency Input

- Integrate recommendations from the 2014 *Mid-City East Small Area Plan* into the Comp Plan.
- Update language to reflect recent development in the Mid-City, Shaw and Convention Center areas.
- Add language in support of the proposed “Cap Park” in Dupont Circle and improvements to C&O Canal in Georgetown.
- Support transit connections between Union Station to Georgetown.
- Re-examine the transportation infrastructure in Foggy Bottom that separates the community from the Potomac River and Rock Creek Park.
- Support the creation of additional recreational opportunities and open space in Near NW - especially in Shaw, Logan Circle, Dupont Circle and Foggy Bottom.
