Public Comment

- Maintain and improve quality of life in residential areas as the city grows.
- Top concerns are traffic, adequate public facilities and services, and housing affordability.
- Commercial corridors and Metro station areas can accommodate growth.
- Make transit, walking, and biking safer, more convenient, and reliable for all.
- Commercial districts need support to remain vibrant and neighborhood-serving.

Agency Input

- Policies should highlight opportunities for new housing for households of varying income levels and sizes.
- Policies should reflect recommendations from the 2016 *Van Ness Commercial District Action Strategy*.
- Policies should incorporating findings from the 2011 *Rock Creek West II Livability Study*.
- Policies for the Wisconsin Avenue corridor should reflect opportunities for transit-oriented redevelopment around Metro stations that could prioritize affordable housing.
