

What We Heard from You: Transportation

Create a safe, sustainable, efficient multi-modal transportation system that meets the access and mobility needs of District residents, the regional workforce, and visitors.

Public Comment

- Make walking in the District safer, easier, and more enjoyable by enhancing pedestrian facilities and filling in gaps.
- Improve transit in the District by providing reliable bus routes in dedicated lanes and increasing Metrorail service hours.
- Work to ensure biking is safe and convenient; the District should build more bike lanes and bike facilities.
- Work to make transportation convenient for all residents, as it is a necessity.

Agency Input

- Recognize the significant investments in the transportation network, including the bridges, Metrorail, buses, and alleys that have been made.
- Identify opportunities the transportation network provides for placemaking and cultural uses.
- Balance freight and delivery of goods, which are critical to the District's economy, with maintaining a safe and efficient transportation network for all users.
- Provide guidance for motor coaches in the District, as they provide access but have significant impacts on the District's transportation network.
- Integrate the District's Vision Zero policy with the goal of eliminating transportation related deaths and minimizing injuries.
- Reflect changing transportation trends in the District and the need to plan for how new technologies will affect transportation options.
- Prioritize sustainability and livability, as identified in the 2014 MoveDC plan.
